





Proposal for Consultation Services June 2024

Partnership Proposal Overview:

The Lindsay Educational Foundation for Learning, a 501.c.3, is pleased to present this proposal to Eureka City Schools to establish a collaborative partnership aimed at supporting strategic design development over the next three years. Our proposal outlines a comprehensive framework for advancing educational practices, fostering innovation, and achieving strategic objectives tailored to the recently developed Portrait of a Graduate, and the unique needs and goals of Eureka City Schools.

Introduction:

Lindsay Leads is the consulting arm of Lindsay Unified School District and the Lindsay Educational Foundation for Learning, specializing in educational leadership, strategic planning, and organizational development. With a diverse team of thirty-five adult staff (certificated, classified, administrative, Board Members and parents) and forty learners, we are a model of uncompromisingly learner centered, personalized, competency-based education. We are practitioners who bring expertise, resources, and a collaborative approach to support our clients in systemic school redesign.

Proposal Objectives:

- Future Focused Strategic Planning: Collaborate with Eureka Public Schools to develop a comprehensive strategic plan aligned with the district's mission, vision, values and portrait of a graduate.
- Innovation Integration: Facilitate the integration of innovative practices and technologies to enhance teaching and learning outcomes across the district.
- Capacity Building: Provide professional learning opportunities and capacity-building initiatives to empower educators and administrators with the skills and knowledge necessary for effective strategic implementation and movement towards a personalized, competency-based system.

- Data-Informed Decision Making: Support the implementation of data-driven decision-making processes to inform strategic design and measure progress towards defined goals.
- Stakeholder Engagement: Engage stakeholders, including learners, parents, teachers, staff, and community members, in the strategic planning process to ensure alignment with community needs and aspirations.
- Establish and maintain a collaborative partnership that supports additions or changes based on the needs as the project advances.

Proposed Timeline:

Year 1: Planning and Assessment/Strategy Development and Implementation

- Support roll out to entire staff during ECS orientation.
- Provide linkage to the Learner Centered Leadership Lab for Superintendent Storts.
- Plan and execute a Lindsay USD Site Visit Fall 2024. Facilitate a two day visitation for key stakeholders (up to 20)
- Deliver Leadership Alignment Series to ensure that all key leaders in formal leadership roles (Certificated, Classified, and Board) understand the why/how/what/when contributing to the Strategic Design.
- Facilitate stakeholder engagement sessions to gather input and perspectives from diverse stakeholders.
- Develop a strategic planning framework and establish key performance indicators (KPIs) for measuring success.
- Collaborate with district leadership to develop a multi-year strategic plan, including mission, vision, core values, guiding principles, clear goals, objectives, and action steps.
- Design professional learning initiatives, to build capacity among educators and administrators in innovative teaching practices and strategic leadership.
- Begin implementation of strategic initiatives, leveraging data-driven decision-making processes to guide ongoing refinement and adaptation.

Lindsay Educational Foundation for Learning (LEFL) will provide:

- 2 day on site visitation at Lindsay Unified School District (Fall 2024)
- 2 day on site visitation at Lindsay Unified SchoolDistrict (Spring 2024)
- 4 days of on site training and development at ECS.
- 36 hours of virtual coaching/support/consultation (one hour/week)

Cost: \$75,000 + Travel Expense

Year 2: Monitoring and Movement towards Competency-Based Teaching/Learning

- Monitor progress towards strategic goals and objectives through regular assessments and data analysis.
- Provide ongoing support, guidance, and coaching to district leadership and staff in addressing challenges and maximizing opportunities for success.
- Conduct mid-term review and evaluation to assess the effectiveness of strategic initiatives and make necessary adjustments.
- Provide professional learning opportunities focused on learner agency, voice and choice, grouping and regrouping.
- Begin development of learning progressions, measurement topics and assessments to transition to a competency-based model.
- Facilitate adoption of a District-wide learning management system
- Establish site-based "Ambassador Teams"

Lindsay Educational Foundation for Learning (LEFL) will provide:

- Another 2 day on site visitation at Lindsay Unified School District (Fall 2025)
- 4 days of on site training and development at ECS.
- 36 hours of virtual coaching/support/consultation (one hour/week) to curriculum design team
- 36 hours of virtual coaching/support/consultation (one hour/week) to Superintendent, Cabinet and site leaders
- 20 hours of learner-to-learner virtual development for Ambassadors.

Cost: \$85,000 + Travel Expense

Year 3: Monitoring and Evaluation

- Support Eureka Public Schools in developing strategies for sustaining momentum and ensuring long-term success beyond the initial partnership period.
- Facilitate workshops and training sessions focused on continual improvement and innovation.

- Collaborate with district leaders to establish mechanisms for ongoing monitoring, evaluation, and strategic planning beyond the partnership period.
- Check and adjust pilot roll out of learning progressions, assessments, grading and competency-based strategies.

Lindsay Educational Foundation for Learning (LEFL) will provide:

- Another 2 day on site visitation at Lindsay Unified School District (Fall 2026)
- 5 days of on site training and development at ECS.
- 36 hours of virtual coaching/support/consultation (one hour/week) to curriculum design team
- 36 hours of virtual coaching/support/consultation (one hour/week) to Superintendent, Cabinet and site leaders

Cost: \$85,000 + Travel Expense
